

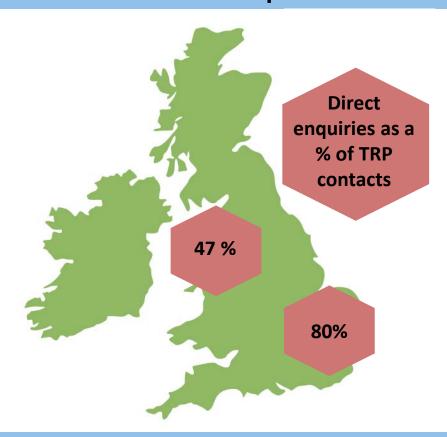
Taylor Review Pilot Lessons Learned
