Newstead's parkland owes much of its beauty to the River Leen, feeding the lakes, ponds and cascades that ornament its gardens, along with its wildlife of peacocks and swans.

Nottingham Castle

With over a thousand years of history on this site, we think Nottingham Castle is a very special place.

There may not be much left of the medieval castle, but the 17th century Ducal Palace is crammed with exhibits and art works, which tell the story of this extraordinary site.
